

## AHBAO High Point Scoring System (R-1-09)

**Un-rated shows, open shows, schooling shows: Halter and performance Points**

5-4-3-2-1 (five places)

Champion and Reserve count as the 1st and 2nd place points.

If there are less than five horses in a class, points will count as follows:

1st place horse = the number of horses in the class, 2<sup>nd</sup>, etc. (Example: 4 horses in a class, 1st place = 4 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 3 points, etc.)

---

**AHA Class A shows, halter and performance points: (AHBAO shows will count double points)**

5-4-3-2-1 (5 places)

If there are less than five horses in a class, points will count as above.

Champion 10 points Reserve Champion 8 points

There must be five horses in a performance class to receive Champion and Reserve Champion points. In Championship classes, points are awarded to Champion and Reserve ONLY!

**REGION 4 and 5, Halter and performance points:**

Champion	20 points
Reserve Champion	16 points
Remaining top five	10 points

Exception: If there are less than five horses in a class, points will be half.

**Recreational Rider Award:** 1 point per hour of pleasure riding to include trail riding, pasture riding or arena riding where a horse is NOT being schooled or trained. Schooling classes, training sessions, paid instruction do NOT count towards this award.
